



BEARFACTS 1996 – 2006

Motley , Texas [48345]

Motley is one of 254 counties in Texas. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2006 population of 1,285 ranked 244th in the state.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2006 Motley had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$21,167. This PCPI ranked 220th in the state and was 60 percent of the state average, \$35,162, and 58 percent of the national average, \$36,794. The 2006 PCPI reflected a decrease of 11.4 percent from 2005. The 2005-2006 state change was 5.8 percent and the national change was 6.1 percent. In 1996 the PCPI of Motley was \$17,091 and ranked 142nd in the state. The 1996-2006 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 2.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.7 percent and for the nation was 4.3 percent.

TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

In 2006 Motley had a total personal income (TPI) of \$27,199*. This TPI ranked 245th in the state and accounted for 0.0 percent of the state total. In 1996 the TPI of Motley was \$23,022* and ranked 244th in the state. The 2006 TPI reflected a decrease of 12.1 percent from 2005. The 2005-2006 state change was 8.3 percent and the national change was 7.1 percent. The 1996-2006 average annual growth rate of TPI was 1.7 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.7 percent and for the nation was 5.4 percent.

COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Motley. In 2006 net earnings accounted for 53.4 percent of TPI (compared with 51.0 in 1996); dividends, interest, and rent were 15.6 percent (compared with 22.0 in 1996); and personal current transfer receipts were 30.9 percent (compared with 27.1 in 1996). From 2005 to 2006 net earnings decreased 19.6 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 12.1 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 4.6 percent. From 1996 to 2006 net earnings increased on average 2.2 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent decreased on average 1.7 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 3.1 percent.

EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK

Earnings of persons employed in Motley decreased from \$16,581* in 2005 to \$13,014* in 2006, a decrease of 21.5 percent. The 2005-2006 state change was 8.7 percent and the national change was 5.8 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1996 estimate of \$11,283* to the 2006 estimate was 1.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 7.1 percent and for the nation was 5.5 percent.
