



## **BEARFACTS 1996 – 2006**

### **Tom Green , Texas [48451]**

Tom Green is one of 254 counties in Texas. It is part of the [San Angelo, TX \(MSA\)](#). Its 2006 population of 105,772 ranked 36th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2006 Tom Green had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$29,692. This PCPI ranked 70th in the state and was 84 percent of the state average, \$35,162, and 81 percent of the national average, \$36,794. The 2006 PCPI reflected an increase of 2.8 percent from 2005. The 2005-2006 state change was 5.8 percent and the national change was 6.1 percent. In 1996 the PCPI of Tom Green was \$19,885 and ranked 64th in the state. The 1996-2006 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.1 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.7 percent and for the nation was 4.3 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2006 Tom Green had a total personal income (TPI) of \$3,140,594\*. This TPI ranked 38th in the state and accounted for 0.4 percent of the state total. In 1996 the TPI of Tom Green was \$2,044,767\* and ranked 32nd in the state. The 2006 TPI reflected an increase of 3.6 percent from 2005. The 2005-2006 state change was 8.3 percent and the national change was 7.1 percent. The 1996-2006 average annual growth rate of TPI was 4.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.7 percent and for the nation was 5.4 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Tom Green. In 2006 net earnings accounted for 63.1 percent of TPI (compared with 62.3 in 1996); dividends, interest, and rent were 18.5 percent (compared with 21.3 in 1996); and personal current transfer receipts were 18.4 percent (compared with 16.4 in 1996). From 2005 to 2006 net earnings increased 3.1 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 3.3 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 5.7 percent. From 1996 to 2006 net earnings increased on average 4.5 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 2.9 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 5.6 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Tom Green increased from \$2,152,736\* in 2005 to \$2,213,528\* in 2006, an increase of 2.8 percent. The 2005-2006 state change was 8.7 percent and the national change was 5.8 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1996 estimate of \$1,427,105\* to the 2006 estimate was 4.5 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 7.1 percent and for the nation was 5.5 percent.
