



## **BEARFACTS 1996 – 2006**

### **Boise City-Nampa (BEA-EA) [57021]**

Boise City-Nampa is one of 179 BEA Economic Areas in the nation. Its 2006 population of 669,855 ranked 96th in the nation.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2006 Boise City-Nampa had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$33,437. This PCPI ranked 50th in the United States and was 91 percent of the national average, \$36,794. The 2006 PCPI reflected an increase of 7.4 percent from 2005. The 2005-2006 national change was 6.1 percent. In 1996 the PCPI of Boise City-Nampa was \$22,413 and ranked 50th in the United States. The 1996-2006 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.1 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 4.3 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2006 Boise City-Nampa had a total personal income (TPI) of \$22,397,942\*. This TPI ranked 91st in the United States. In 1996 the TPI of Boise City-Nampa was \$11,341,143\* and ranked 101st in the United States. The 2006 TPI reflected an increase of 11.3 percent from 2005. The 2005-2006 national change was 7.1 percent. The 1996-2006 average annual growth rate of TPI was 7.0 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.4 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Boise City-Nampa. In 2006 net earnings accounted for 68.7 percent of TPI (compared with 69.3 in 1996); dividends, interest, and rent were 19.0 percent (compared with 18.9 in 1996); and personal current transfer receipts were 12.3 percent (compared with 11.8 in 1996). From 2005 to 2006 net earnings increased 10.7 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 15.5 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 8.2 percent. From 1996 to 2006 net earnings increased on average 6.9 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 7.1 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 7.5 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Boise City-Nampa increased from \$15,544,782\* in 2005 to \$17,258,970\* in 2006, an increase of 11.0 percent. The 2005-2006 national change was 5.8 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1996 estimate of \$8,877,501\* to the 2006 estimate was 6.9 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.5 percent.
