



BEARFACTS 1997 – 2007

Cumberland , Illinois [17035]

Cumberland is one of 102 counties in Illinois. It is part of the Charleston-Mattoon, IL Micropolitan SA. Its 2007 population of 10,827 ranked 87th in the state.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2007 Cumberland had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$28,977. This PCPI ranked 58th in the state and was 71 percent of the state average, \$41,012, and 75 percent of the national average, \$38,615. The 2007 PCPI reflected an increase of 9.3 percent from 2006. The 2006-2007 state change was 6.6 percent and the national change was 4.9 percent. In 1997 the PCPI of Cumberland was \$21,111 and ranked 57th in the state. The 1997-2007 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.0 percent and for the nation was 4.3 percent.

TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

In 2007 Cumberland had a total personal income (TPI) of \$313,733*. This TPI ranked 86th in the state and accounted for 0.1 percent of the state total. In 1997 the TPI of Cumberland was \$236,145* and ranked 86th in the state. The 2007 TPI reflected an increase of 8.7 percent from 2006. The 2006-2007 state change was 7.2 percent and the national change was 6.0 percent. The 1997-2007 average annual growth rate of TPI was 2.9 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.5 percent and for the nation was 5.4 percent.

COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Cumberland. In 2007 net earnings accounted for 67.7 percent of TPI (compared with 66.1 in 1997); dividends, interest, and rent were 11.8 percent (compared with 18.2 in 1997); and personal current transfer receipts were 20.4 percent (compared with 15.7 in 1997). From 2006 to 2007 net earnings increased 8.1 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 3.8 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 13.9 percent. From 1997 to 2007 net earnings increased on average 3.1 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent decreased on average 1.5 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 5.6 percent.

EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK

Earnings of persons employed in Cumberland increased from \$110,839* in 2006 to \$125,564* in 2007, an increase of 13.3 percent. The 2006-2007 state change was 4.8 percent and the national change was 4.9 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1997 estimate of \$73,435* to the 2007 estimate was 5.5 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.5 percent and for the nation was 5.4 percent.
