



BEARFACTS 1997 – 2007

Geary , Kansas [20061]

Geary is one of 105 counties in Kansas. It is part of the [Manhattan, KS \(MSA\)](#). Its 2007 population of 29,539 ranked 19th in the state.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2007 Geary had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$36,912. This PCPI ranked 11th in the state and was 101 percent of the state average, \$36,525, and 96 percent of the national average, \$38,615. The 2007 PCPI reflected an increase of 12.1 percent from 2006. The 2006-2007 state change was 5.8 percent and the national change was 4.9 percent. In 1997 the PCPI of Geary was \$19,717 and ranked 73rd in the state. The 1997-2007 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 6.5 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.3 percent and for the nation was 4.3 percent.

TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

In 2007 Geary had a total personal income (TPI) of \$1,090,335*. This TPI ranked 13th in the state and accounted for 1.1 percent of the state total. In 1997 the TPI of Geary was \$546,137* and ranked 23rd in the state. The 2007 TPI reflected an increase of 14.2 percent from 2006. The 2006-2007 state change was 6.6 percent and the national change was 6.0 percent. The 1997-2007 average annual growth rate of TPI was 7.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.8 percent and for the nation was 5.4 percent.

COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Geary. In 2007 net earnings accounted for 78.4 percent of TPI (compared with 70.0 in 1997); dividends, interest, and rent were 11.2 percent (compared with 17.5 in 1997); and personal current transfer receipts were 10.4 percent (compared with 12.5 in 1997). From 2006 to 2007 net earnings increased 16.2 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 10.6 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 4.3 percent. From 1997 to 2007 net earnings increased on average 8.4 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 2.5 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 5.2 percent.

EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK

Earnings of persons employed in Geary increased from \$1,585,670* in 2006 to \$1,971,937* in 2007, an increase of 24.4 percent. The 2006-2007 state change was 6.4 percent and the national change was 4.9 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1997 estimate of \$784,222* to the 2007 estimate was 9.7 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.1 percent and for the nation was 5.4 percent.
