



BEARFACTS 1997 – 2007

Flint (MSA) [22420]

Flint is one of 363 Metropolitan Statistical Areas (MSAs) in the nation. Its 2007 population of 434,027 ranked 111th in the nation.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2007 Flint had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$28,700. This PCPI ranked 310th in the United States and was 74 percent of the national average, \$38,615. The 2007 PCPI reflected an increase of 3.1 percent from 2006. The 2006-2007 national change was 4.9 percent. In 1997 the PCPI of Flint was \$23,879 and ranked 129th in the United States. The 1997-2007 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 1.9 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 4.3 percent.

TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

In 2007 Flint had a total personal income (TPI) of \$12,456,774*. This TPI ranked 133rd in the United States. In 1997 the TPI of Flint was \$10,339,077* and ranked 101st in the United States. The 2007 TPI reflected an increase of 2.2 percent from 2006. The 2006-2007 national change was 6.0 percent. The 1997-2007 average annual growth rate of TPI was 1.9 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.4 percent.

COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Flint. In 2007 net earnings accounted for 62.1 percent of TPI (compared with 66.8 in 1997); dividends, interest, and rent were 13.3 percent (compared with 16.0 in 1997); and personal current transfer receipts were 24.7 percent (compared with 17.2 in 1997). From 2006 to 2007 net earnings decreased 0.7 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 8.0 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 7.3 percent. From 1997 to 2007 net earnings increased on average 1.1 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent remained unchanged; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 5.6 percent.

EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK

Earnings of persons employed in Flint decreased from \$8,441,099* in 2006 to \$8,309,003* in 2007, a decrease of 1.6 percent. The 2006-2007 national change was 4.9 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1997 estimate of \$7,903,508* to the 2007 estimate was 0.5 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.4 percent.
