



## **BEARFACTS 1997 – 2007**

### **Anne Arundel , Maryland [24003]**

Anne Arundel is one of 24 counties in Maryland. It is part of the [Baltimore-Towson, MD \(MSA\)](#). Its 2007 population of 510,507 ranked 5th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2007 Anne Arundel had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$51,890. This PCPI ranked 4th in the state and was 112 percent of the state average, \$46,471, and 134 percent of the national average, \$38,615. The 2007 PCPI reflected an increase of 5.3 percent from 2006. The 2006-2007 state change was 5.9 percent and the national change was 4.9 percent. In 1997 the PCPI of Anne Arundel was \$29,990 and ranked 5th in the state. The 1997-2007 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 5.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.9 percent and for the nation was 4.3 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2007 Anne Arundel had a total personal income (TPI) of \$26,489,989\*. This TPI ranked 4th in the state and accounted for 10.1 percent of the state total. In 1997 the TPI of Anne Arundel was \$14,166,145\* and ranked 5th in the state. The 2007 TPI reflected an increase of 5.6 percent from 2006. The 2006-2007 state change was 6.2 percent and the national change was 6.0 percent. The 1997-2007 average annual growth rate of TPI was 6.5 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.9 percent and for the nation was 5.4 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Anne Arundel. In 2007 net earnings accounted for 75.1 percent of TPI (compared with 73.5 in 1997); dividends, interest, and rent were 15.9 percent (compared with 17.9 in 1997); and personal current transfer receipts were 8.9 percent (compared with 8.6 in 1997). From 2006 to 2007 net earnings increased 4.2 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 11.1 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 7.4 percent. From 1997 to 2007 net earnings increased on average 6.7 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 5.2 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 6.9 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Anne Arundel increased from \$19,759,840\* in 2006 to \$20,981,898\* in 2007, an increase of 6.2 percent. The 2006-2007 state change was 4.8 percent and the national change was 4.9 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1997 estimate of \$9,392,418\* to the 2007 estimate was 8.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.1 percent and for the nation was 5.4 percent.
