



BEARFACTS 1997 – 2007

Arthur , Nebraska [31005]

Arthur is one of 93 counties in Nebraska. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2007 population of 354 ranked 93rd in the state.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2007 Arthur had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$18,853. This PCPI ranked 88th in the state and was 52 percent of the state average, \$36,372, and 49 percent of the national average, \$38,615. The 2007 PCPI reflected an increase of 3.2 percent from 2006. The 2006-2007 state change was 6.8 percent and the national change was 4.9 percent. In 1997 the PCPI of Arthur was \$4,909 and ranked 93rd in the state. The 1997-2007 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 14.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.2 percent and for the nation was 4.3 percent.

TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

In 2007 Arthur had a total personal income (TPI) of \$6,674*. This TPI ranked 92nd in the state and accounted for 0.0 percent of the state total. In 1997 the TPI of Arthur was \$2,160* and ranked 93rd in the state. The 2007 TPI remained unchanged from 2006. The 2006-2007 state change was 7.4 percent and the national change was 6.0 percent. The 1997-2007 average annual growth rate of TPI was 11.9 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.7 percent and for the nation was 5.4 percent.

COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Arthur. In 2007 net earnings accounted for 20.6 percent of TPI; dividends, interest, and rent were 43.9 percent (compared with 117.9 in 1997); and personal current transfer receipts were 35.4 percent (compared with 63.0 in 1997). From 2006 to 2007 net earnings decreased 20.0 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 4.8 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 9.8 percent. From 1997 to 2007 net earnings cannot be calculated; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 1.4 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 5.7 percent.

EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK

Earnings of persons employed in Arthur decreased from \$506* in 2006 to \$44* in 2007, a decrease of 91.3 percent. The 2006-2007 state change was 6.8 percent and the national change was 4.9 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1997 estimate of \$- 2,391* to the 2007 estimate cannot be calculated. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.8 percent and for the nation was 5.4 percent.
