



## **BEARFACTS 1997 – 2007**

### **Clark , South Dakota [46025]**

Clark is one of 66 counties in South Dakota. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2007 population of 3,467 ranked 44th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2007 Clark had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$37,357. This PCPI ranked 19th in the state and was 104 percent of the state average, \$35,760, and 97 percent of the national average, \$38,615. The 2007 PCPI reflected an increase of 40.9 percent from 2006. The 2006-2007 state change was 10.7 percent and the national change was 4.9 percent. In 1997 the PCPI of Clark was \$22,038 and ranked 21st in the state. The 1997-2007 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 5.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.0 percent and for the nation was 4.3 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2007 Clark had a total personal income (TPI) of \$129,516\*. This TPI ranked 42nd in the state and accounted for 0.5 percent of the state total. In 1997 the TPI of Clark was \$94,368\* and ranked 39th in the state. The 2007 TPI reflected an increase of 38.6 percent from 2006. The 2006-2007 state change was 11.9 percent and the national change was 6.0 percent. The 1997-2007 average annual growth rate of TPI was 3.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.7 percent and for the nation was 5.4 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Clark. In 2007 net earnings accounted for 70.1 percent of TPI (compared with 61.9 in 1997); dividends, interest, and rent were 13.5 percent (compared with 22.2 in 1997); and personal current transfer receipts were 16.4 percent (compared with 15.9 in 1997). From 2006 to 2007 net earnings increased 58.9 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 8.9 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 5.1 percent. From 1997 to 2007 net earnings increased on average 4.5 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent decreased on average 1.8 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 3.6 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Clark increased from \$53,242\* in 2006 to \$86,312\* in 2007, an increase of 62.1 percent. The 2006-2007 state change was 12.2 percent and the national change was 4.9 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1997 estimate of \$57,372\* to the 2007 estimate was 4.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.5 percent and for the nation was 5.4 percent.
