



BEARFACTS 1997 – 2007

Sutton , Texas [48435]

Sutton is one of 254 counties in Texas. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2007 population of 4,271 ranked 207th in the state.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2007 Sutton had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$39,469. This PCPI ranked 15th in the state and was 106 percent of the state average, \$37,083, and 102 percent of the national average, \$38,615. The 2007 PCPI reflected an increase of 20.7 percent from 2006. The 2006-2007 state change was 5.5 percent and the national change was 4.9 percent. In 1997 the PCPI of Sutton was \$17,015 and ranked 188th in the state. The 1997-2007 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 8.8 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.6 percent and for the nation was 4.3 percent.

TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

In 2007 Sutton had a total personal income (TPI) of \$168,572*. This TPI ranked 195th in the state and accounted for 0.0 percent of the state total. In 1997 the TPI of Sutton was \$74,067* and ranked 214th in the state. The 2007 TPI reflected an increase of 21.1 percent from 2006. The 2006-2007 state change was 7.6 percent and the national change was 6.0 percent. The 1997-2007 average annual growth rate of TPI was 8.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.6 percent and for the nation was 5.4 percent.

COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Sutton. In 2007 net earnings accounted for 74.9 percent of TPI (compared with 58.0 in 1997); dividends, interest, and rent were 12.8 percent (compared with 25.4 in 1997); and personal current transfer receipts were 12.3 percent (compared with 16.6 in 1997). From 2006 to 2007 net earnings increased 25.9 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 13.0 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 4.5 percent. From 1997 to 2007 net earnings increased on average 11.4 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 1.4 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 5.4 percent.

EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK

Earnings of persons employed in Sutton increased from \$130,304* in 2006 to \$165,674* in 2007, an increase of 27.1 percent. The 2006-2007 state change was 7.6 percent and the national change was 4.9 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1997 estimate of \$53,751* to the 2007 estimate was 11.9 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.8 percent and for the nation was 5.4 percent.
