



BEARFACTS 1997 – 2007

King and Queen , Virginia [51097]

King and Queen is one of 105 counties in Virginia. It is part of the [Richmond, VA \(MSA\)](#). Its 2007 population of 6,864 ranked 102nd in the state.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2007 King and Queen had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$28,972. This PCPI ranked 63rd in the state and was 69 percent of the state average, \$41,727, and 75 percent of the national average, \$38,615. The 2007 PCPI reflected an increase of 2.8 percent from 2006. The 2006-2007 state change was 3.7 percent and the national change was 4.9 percent. In 1997 the PCPI of King and Queen was \$19,977 and ranked 59th in the state. The 1997-2007 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.8 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.7 percent and for the nation was 4.3 percent.

TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

In 2007 King and Queen had a total personal income (TPI) of \$198,866*. This TPI ranked 100th in the state and accounted for 0.1 percent of the state total. In 1997 the TPI of King and Queen was \$131,328* and ranked 100th in the state. The 2007 TPI reflected an increase of 3.3 percent from 2006. The 2006-2007 state change was 4.7 percent and the national change was 6.0 percent. The 1997-2007 average annual growth rate of TPI was 4.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.0 percent and for the nation was 5.4 percent.

COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of King and Queen. In 2007 net earnings accounted for 70.8 percent of TPI (compared with 68.8 in 1997); dividends, interest, and rent were 8.4 percent (compared with 14.8 in 1997); and personal current transfer receipts were 20.7 percent (compared with 16.4 in 1997). From 2006 to 2007 net earnings increased 2.6 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 2.1 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 6.4 percent. From 1997 to 2007 net earnings increased on average 4.5 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent decreased on average 1.4 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 6.7 percent.

EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK

Earnings of persons employed in King and Queen increased from \$71,398* in 2006 to \$73,516* in 2007, an increase of 3.0 percent. The 2006-2007 state change was 4.6 percent and the national change was 4.9 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1997 estimate of \$39,937* to the 2007 estimate was 6.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.4 percent and for the nation was 5.4 percent.
