Expert Group Discussion

- Statement 1: There are many, highly functioning organizations that are making a real difference in supporting evidence building and program administration—FSRDCs, state coalitions, university and non-profit led efforts. In addition to filling gaps, the NSDS must connect this data ecosystem to help guide users to resources that can meet their needs through a concierge service. As a statistical system we hope a modest first step will be introduction of the Standard Application Process for accessing all federal statistical data assets.
- Statement 2: The capacity for using data varies widely, especially across various levels of government. A key role of an NSDS must be to provide training and access to tools in order to increase capacity across the ecosystem. While we have much to learn, we as a statistical system are energized by the opportunity for sharing our collective experience in developing new analytical methods, supporting high impact research, disseminating quality data, and protecting data confidentiality.
- Statement 3: New resources will be required to support both an NSDS and build capacity across the ecosystem (data providers and data users) to fully realize the vision of the report.



Future Engagement

Expert Group Discussion

- Engagement Area 1: The statistical agencies must do a better job of communicating how they
 are working together and seek new ways to engage with a broader range of users to effectively
 deliver the goals of the Evidence Act.
- Engagement Area 2: The statistical agencies should harness current opportunities to engage in "use cases" that promote data sharing, linkage, and privacy protection and demonstrate the value of collaboration across the Statistical System.
- Engagement Area 3: The statistical agencies should continue to make progress on Evidence Act regulations and implementation processes.
- Engagement Area 4: That statistical agencies, working within the Interagency Council on Statistical Policy, should establish clarity around the initial NSDS governance and functions and set in place a process to continue to evolve these through experience and user feedback.
