



## **BEARFACTS 1989 – 1999**

### **Fremont (includes Yellowstone Park) , Idaho [16043]**

Fremont (includes Yellowstone Park) is one of 44 counties in Idaho. It is part of the Rexburg, ID Micropolitan SA. Its 1999 population of 11,840 ranked 23rd in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 1999 Fremont (includes Yellowstone Park) had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$16,942. This PCPI ranked 40th in the state and was 74 percent of the state average, \$22,786, and 61 percent of the national average, \$27,939. The 1999 PCPI reflected an increase of 3.3 percent from 1998. The 1998-1999 state change was 4.6 percent and the national change was 3.9 percent. In 1989 the PCPI of Fremont (includes Yellowstone Park) was \$12,121 and ranked 34th in the state. The 1989-1999 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.5 percent and for the nation was 4.2 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 1999 Fremont (includes Yellowstone Park) had a total personal income (TPI) of \$200,589\*. This TPI ranked 24th in the state and accounted for 0.7 percent of the state total. In 1989 the TPI of Fremont (includes Yellowstone Park) was \$132,544\* and ranked 23rd in the state. The 1999 TPI reflected an increase of 2.9 percent from 1998. The 1998-1999 state change was 6.5 percent and the national change was 5.1 percent. The 1989-1999 average annual growth rate of TPI was 4.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 7.1 percent and for the nation was 5.5 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Fremont (includes Yellowstone Park). In 1999 net earnings accounted for 63.1 percent of TPI (compared with 65.5 in 1989); dividends, interest, and rent were 21.0 percent (compared with 21.7 in 1989); and personal current transfer receipts were 15.9 percent (compared with 12.8 in 1989). From 1998 to 1999 net earnings increased 4.0 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 0.3 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 3.0 percent. From 1989 to 1999 net earnings increased on average 3.8 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 3.9 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 6.5 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Fremont (includes Yellowstone Park) increased from \$104,278\* in 1998 to \$105,502\* in 1999, an increase of 1.2 percent. The 1998-1999 state change was 8.1 percent and the national change was 6.8 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1989 estimate of \$82,537\* to the 1999 estimate was 2.5 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 7.0 percent and for the nation was 5.6 percent.
