



BEARFACTS 1989 – 1999

Boyd , Nebraska [31015]

Boyd is one of 93 counties in Nebraska. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 1999 population of 2,458 ranked 74th in the state.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 1999 Boyd had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$17,698. This PCPI ranked 81st in the state and was 67 percent of the state average, \$26,465, and 63 percent of the national average, \$27,939. The 1999 PCPI reflected a decrease of 4.3 percent from 1998. The 1998-1999 state change was 3.6 percent and the national change was 3.9 percent. In 1989 the PCPI of Boyd was \$12,871 and ranked 83rd in the state. The 1989-1999 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.6 percent and for the nation was 4.2 percent.

TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

In 1999 Boyd had a total personal income (TPI) of \$43,501*. This TPI ranked 78th in the state and accounted for 0.1 percent of the state total. In 1989 the TPI of Boyd was \$36,926* and ranked 77th in the state. The 1999 TPI reflected a decrease of 6.2 percent from 1998. The 1998-1999 state change was 4.2 percent and the national change was 5.1 percent. The 1989-1999 average annual growth rate of TPI was 1.7 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.5 percent and for the nation was 5.5 percent.

COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Boyd. In 1999 net earnings accounted for 43.2 percent of TPI (compared with 48.8 in 1989); dividends, interest, and rent were 29.2 percent (compared with 30.5 in 1989); and personal current transfer receipts were 27.6 percent (compared with 20.6 in 1989). From 1998 to 1999 net earnings decreased 11.4 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 5.5 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 2.4 percent. From 1989 to 1999 net earnings increased on average 0.4 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 1.2 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 4.6 percent.

EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK

Earnings of persons employed in Boyd decreased from \$22,664* in 1998 to \$19,959* in 1999, a decrease of 11.9 percent. The 1998-1999 state change was 5.1 percent and the national change was 6.8 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1989 estimate of \$20,660* to the 1999 estimate was - 0.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.5 percent and for the nation was 5.6 percent.
