



## **BEARFACTS 1989 – 1999**

### **Atascosa , Texas [48013]**

Atascosa is one of 254 counties in Texas. It is part of the [San Antonio, TX \(MSA\)](#). Its 1999 population of 37,736 ranked 72nd in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 1999 Atascosa had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$17,580. This PCPI ranked 197th in the state and was 67 percent of the state average, \$26,250, and 63 percent of the national average, \$27,939. The 1999 PCPI reflected an increase of 4.9 percent from 1998. The 1998-1999 state change was 4.2 percent and the national change was 3.9 percent. In 1989 the PCPI of Atascosa was \$11,265 and ranked 217th in the state. The 1989-1999 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.9 percent and for the nation was 4.2 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 1999 Atascosa had a total personal income (TPI) of \$663,409\*. This TPI ranked 81st in the state and accounted for 0.1 percent of the state total. In 1989 the TPI of Atascosa was \$343,591\* and ranked 82nd in the state. The 1999 TPI reflected an increase of 7.7 percent from 1998. The 1998-1999 state change was 6.3 percent and the national change was 5.1 percent. The 1989-1999 average annual growth rate of TPI was 6.8 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 7.0 percent and for the nation was 5.5 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Atascosa. In 1999 net earnings accounted for 68.9 percent of TPI (compared with 64.3 in 1989); dividends, interest, and rent were 12.6 percent (compared with 20.0 in 1989); and personal current transfer receipts were 18.5 percent (compared with 15.8 in 1989). From 1998 to 1999 net earnings increased 11.3 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 3.9 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 3.6 percent. From 1989 to 1999 net earnings increased on average 7.5 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 2.0 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 8.6 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Atascosa increased from \$283,620\* in 1998 to \$313,023\* in 1999, an increase of 10.4 percent. The 1998-1999 state change was 7.9 percent and the national change was 6.8 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1989 estimate of \$138,769\* to the 1999 estimate was 8.5 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 7.5 percent and for the nation was 5.6 percent.
