



## **BEARFACTS 1989 – 1999**

### **Llano , Texas [48299]**

Llano is one of 254 counties in Texas. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 1999 population of 16,510 ranked 131st in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 1999 Llano had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$21,779. This PCPI ranked 99th in the state and was 83 percent of the state average, \$26,250, and 78 percent of the national average, \$27,939. The 1999 PCPI reflected an increase of 2.1 percent from 1998. The 1998-1999 state change was 4.2 percent and the national change was 3.9 percent. In 1989 the PCPI of Llano was \$15,145 and ranked 60th in the state. The 1989-1999 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.7 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.9 percent and for the nation was 4.2 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 1999 Llano had a total personal income (TPI) of \$359,573\*. This TPI ranked 124th in the state and accounted for 0.1 percent of the state total. In 1989 the TPI of Llano was \$177,587\* and ranked 137th in the state. The 1999 TPI reflected an increase of 6.8 percent from 1998. The 1998-1999 state change was 6.3 percent and the national change was 5.1 percent. The 1989-1999 average annual growth rate of TPI was 7.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 7.0 percent and for the nation was 5.5 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Llano. In 1999 net earnings accounted for 48.6 percent of TPI (compared with 35.8 in 1989); dividends, interest, and rent were 27.1 percent (compared with 40.2 in 1989); and personal current transfer receipts were 24.2 percent (compared with 24.0 in 1989). From 1998 to 1999 net earnings increased 14.4 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 4.7 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 6.9 percent. From 1989 to 1999 net earnings increased on average 10.7 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 3.2 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 7.4 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Llano increased from \$123,118\* in 1998 to \$135,655\* in 1999, an increase of 10.2 percent. The 1998-1999 state change was 7.9 percent and the national change was 6.8 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1989 estimate of \$64,881\* to the 1999 estimate was 7.7 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 7.5 percent and for the nation was 5.6 percent.
