



## **BEARFACTS 1989 – 1999**

### **McMullen , Texas [48311]**

McMullen is one of 254 counties in Texas. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 1999 population of 832 ranked 250th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 1999 McMullen had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$25,042. This PCPI ranked 41st in the state and was 95 percent of the state average, \$26,250, and 90 percent of the national average, \$27,939. The 1999 PCPI reflected an increase of 6.7 percent from 1998. The 1998-1999 state change was 4.2 percent and the national change was 3.9 percent. In 1989 the PCPI of McMullen was \$16,933 and ranked 26th in the state. The 1989-1999 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.0 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.9 percent and for the nation was 4.2 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 1999 McMullen had a total personal income (TPI) of \$20,835\*. This TPI ranked 248th in the state and accounted for 0.0 percent of the state total. In 1989 the TPI of McMullen was \$13,817\* and ranked 248th in the state. The 1999 TPI reflected an increase of 7.4 percent from 1998. The 1998-1999 state change was 6.3 percent and the national change was 5.1 percent. The 1989-1999 average annual growth rate of TPI was 4.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 7.0 percent and for the nation was 5.5 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of McMullen. In 1999 net earnings accounted for 43.8 percent of TPI (compared with 45.0 in 1989); dividends, interest, and rent were 43.1 percent (compared with 46.7 in 1989); and personal current transfer receipts were 13.1 percent (compared with 8.3 in 1989). From 1998 to 1999 net earnings increased 18.9 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 1.8 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 6.5 percent. From 1989 to 1999 net earnings increased on average 3.9 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 3.4 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 9.1 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in McMullen increased from \$8,963\* in 1998 to \$10,376\* in 1999, an increase of 15.8 percent. The 1998-1999 state change was 7.9 percent and the national change was 6.8 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1989 estimate of \$10,762\* to the 1999 estimate was - 0.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 7.5 percent and for the nation was 5.6 percent.

*\*Note: All income estimates with the exception of PCPI are in thousands of dollars, not adjusted for inflation.*
