



## **BEARFACTS 1989 – 1999**

### **Mitchell , Texas [48335]**

Mitchell is one of 254 counties in Texas. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 1999 population of 9,822 ranked 166th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 1999 Mitchell had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$14,543. This PCPI ranked 236th in the state and was 55 percent of the state average, \$26,250, and 52 percent of the national average, \$27,939. The 1999 PCPI reflected an increase of 6.2 percent from 1998. The 1998-1999 state change was 4.2 percent and the national change was 3.9 percent. In 1989 the PCPI of Mitchell was \$12,297 and ranked 187th in the state. The 1989-1999 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 1.7 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.9 percent and for the nation was 4.2 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 1999 Mitchell had a total personal income (TPI) of \$142,839\*. This TPI ranked 188th in the state and accounted for 0.0 percent of the state total. In 1989 the TPI of Mitchell was \$101,881\* and ranked 178th in the state. The 1999 TPI reflected an increase of 6.0 percent from 1998. The 1998-1999 state change was 6.3 percent and the national change was 5.1 percent. The 1989-1999 average annual growth rate of TPI was 3.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 7.0 percent and for the nation was 5.5 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Mitchell. In 1999 net earnings accounted for 54.7 percent of TPI (compared with 52.0 in 1989); dividends, interest, and rent were 18.9 percent (compared with 26.2 in 1989); and personal current transfer receipts were 26.4 percent (compared with 21.8 in 1989). From 1998 to 1999 net earnings increased 16.0 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 8.9 percent; and personal current transfer receipts decreased 0.2 percent. From 1989 to 1999 net earnings increased on average 4.0 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 0.1 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 5.4 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Mitchell increased from \$72,755\* in 1998 to \$85,328\* in 1999, an increase of 17.3 percent. The 1998-1999 state change was 7.9 percent and the national change was 6.8 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1989 estimate of \$55,157\* to the 1999 estimate was 4.5 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 7.5 percent and for the nation was 5.6 percent.
