



## **BEARFACTS 1989 – 1999**

### **Winkler , Texas [48495]**

Winkler is one of 254 counties in Texas. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 1999 population of 7,389 ranked 186th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 1999 Winkler had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$17,072. This PCPI ranked 211th in the state and was 65 percent of the state average, \$26,250, and 61 percent of the national average, \$27,939. The 1999 PCPI remained unchanged from 1998. The 1998-1999 state change was 4.2 percent and the national change was 3.9 percent. In 1989 the PCPI of Winkler was \$11,438 and ranked 210th in the state. The 1989-1999 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.1 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.9 percent and for the nation was 4.2 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 1999 Winkler had a total personal income (TPI) of \$126,144\*. This TPI ranked 194th in the state and accounted for 0.0 percent of the state total. In 1989 the TPI of Winkler was \$100,296\* and ranked 180th in the state. The 1999 TPI reflected a decrease of 3.0 percent from 1998. The 1998-1999 state change was 6.3 percent and the national change was 5.1 percent. The 1989-1999 average annual growth rate of TPI was 2.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 7.0 percent and for the nation was 5.5 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Winkler. In 1999 net earnings accounted for 59.3 percent of TPI (compared with 60.8 in 1989); dividends, interest, and rent were 16.3 percent (compared with 23.6 in 1989); and personal current transfer receipts were 24.4 percent (compared with 15.6 in 1989). From 1998 to 1999 net earnings decreased 4.6 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 6.8 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 4.1 percent. From 1989 to 1999 net earnings increased on average 2.1 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent decreased on average 1.4 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 7.0 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Winkler decreased from \$81,177\* in 1998 to \$77,886\* in 1999, a decrease of 4.1 percent. The 1998-1999 state change was 7.9 percent and the national change was 6.8 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1989 estimate of \$60,578\* to the 1999 estimate was 2.5 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 7.5 percent and for the nation was 5.6 percent.
