



## **BEARFACTS 1989 – 1999**

### **Boise City-Nampa (BEA-EA) [57021]**

Boise City-Nampa is one of 179 BEA Economic Areas in the nation. Its 1999 population of 554,837 ranked 106th in the nation.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 1999 Boise City-Nampa had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$25,150. This PCPI ranked 57th in the United States and was 90 percent of the national average, \$27,939. The 1999 PCPI reflected an increase of 5.2 percent from 1998. The 1998-1999 national change was 3.9 percent. In 1989 the PCPI of Boise City-Nampa was \$15,915 and ranked 72nd in the United States. The 1989-1999 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.7 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 4.2 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 1999 Boise City-Nampa had a total personal income (TPI) of \$13,954,321<sup>\*</sup>. This TPI ranked 99th in the United States. In 1989 the TPI of Boise City-Nampa was \$6,275,423<sup>\*</sup> and ranked 117th in the United States. The 1999 TPI reflected an increase of 8.2 percent from 1998. The 1998-1999 national change was 5.1 percent. The 1989-1999 average annual growth rate of TPI was 8.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.5 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Boise City-Nampa. In 1999 net earnings accounted for 69.9 percent of TPI (compared with 69.2 in 1989); dividends, interest, and rent were 19.0 percent (compared with 19.3 in 1989); and personal current transfer receipts were 11.2 percent (compared with 11.6 in 1989). From 1998 to 1999 net earnings increased 10.2 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 2.4 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 6.8 percent. From 1989 to 1999 net earnings increased on average 8.4 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 8.1 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 7.9 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Boise City-Nampa increased from \$9,969,021<sup>\*</sup> in 1998 to \$10,956,692<sup>\*</sup> in 1999, an increase of 9.9 percent. The 1998-1999 national change was 6.8 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1989 estimate of \$4,881,714<sup>\*</sup> to the 1999 estimate was 8.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.6 percent.
