



## **BEARFACTS 1989 – 1999**

### **Dothan-Enterprise-Ozark (BEA-EA) [57048]**

Dothan-Enterprise-Ozark is one of 179 BEA Economic Areas in the nation. Its 1999 population of 292,027 ranked 148th in the nation.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 1999 Dothan-Enterprise-Ozark had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$21,153. This PCPI ranked 147th in the United States and was 76 percent of the national average, \$27,939. The 1999 PCPI reflected an increase of 3.7 percent from 1998. The 1998-1999 national change was 3.9 percent. In 1989 the PCPI of Dothan-Enterprise-Ozark was \$14,365 and ranked 137th in the United States. The 1989-1999 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.9 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 4.2 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 1999 Dothan-Enterprise-Ozark had a total personal income (TPI) of \$6,177,164\*. This TPI ranked 145th in the United States. In 1989 the TPI of Dothan-Enterprise-Ozark was \$3,935,485\* and ranked 143rd in the United States. The 1999 TPI reflected an increase of 4.2 percent from 1998. The 1998-1999 national change was 5.1 percent. The 1989-1999 average annual growth rate of TPI was 4.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.5 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Dothan-Enterprise-Ozark. In 1999 net earnings accounted for 64.8 percent of TPI (compared with 68.0 in 1989); dividends, interest, and rent were 17.0 percent (compared with 17.5 in 1989); and personal current transfer receipts were 18.2 percent (compared with 14.4 in 1989). From 1998 to 1999 net earnings increased 5.8 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 1.9 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 4.7 percent. From 1989 to 1999 net earnings increased on average 4.1 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 4.3 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 7.1 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Dothan-Enterprise-Ozark increased from \$4,235,100\* in 1998 to \$4,472,230\* in 1999, an increase of 5.6 percent. The 1998-1999 national change was 6.8 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1989 estimate of \$2,968,255\* to the 1999 estimate was 4.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.6 percent.
