



## **BEARFACTS 1989 – 1999**

### **Salina (BEA-EA) [57141]**

Salina is one of 179 BEA Economic Areas in the nation. Its 1999 population of 200,417 ranked 165th in the nation.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 1999 Salina had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$23,501. This PCPI ranked 82nd in the United States and was 84 percent of the national average, \$27,939. The 1999 PCPI reflected an increase of 1.7 percent from 1998. The 1998-1999 national change was 3.9 percent. In 1989 the PCPI of Salina was \$15,552 and ranked 86th in the United States. The 1989-1999 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 4.2 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 1999 Salina had a total personal income (TPI) of \$4,709,905\*. This TPI ranked 165th in the United States. In 1989 the TPI of Salina was \$3,155,176\* and ranked 156th in the United States. The 1999 TPI reflected an increase of 1.4 percent from 1998. The 1998-1999 national change was 5.1 percent. The 1989-1999 average annual growth rate of TPI was 4.1 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.5 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Salina. In 1999 net earnings accounted for 61.3 percent of TPI (compared with 57.5 in 1989); dividends, interest, and rent were 21.9 percent (compared with 27.0 in 1989); and personal current transfer receipts were 16.8 percent (compared with 15.5 in 1989). From 1998 to 1999 net earnings increased 2.7 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 2.8 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 2.3 percent. From 1989 to 1999 net earnings increased on average 4.8 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 1.9 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 5.0 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Salina increased from \$3,169,840\* in 1998 to \$3,257,141\* in 1999, an increase of 2.8 percent. The 1998-1999 national change was 6.8 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1989 estimate of \$2,024,025\* to the 1999 estimate was 4.9 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.6 percent.
