



BEARFACTS 1990 – 2000

Kodiak Island Borough , Alaska [02150]

Kodiak Island Borough is one of 27 counties in Alaska. It is part of the Kodiak, AK Micropolitan SA. Its 2000 population of 13,955 ranked 8th in the state.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2000 Kodiak Island Borough had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$26,741. This PCPI ranked 15th in the state and was 90 percent of the state average, \$29,870, and 90 percent of the national average, \$29,847. The 2000 PCPI reflected an increase of 5.8 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 state change was 6.3 percent and the national change was 6.8 percent. In 1990 the PCPI of Kodiak Island Borough was \$21,932 and ranked 10th in the state. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 2.0 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 2.7 percent and for the nation was 4.4 percent.

TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

In 2000 Kodiak Island Borough had a total personal income (TPI) of \$373,164*. This TPI ranked 7th in the state and accounted for 2.0 percent of the state total. In 1990 the TPI of Kodiak Island Borough was \$293,470* and ranked 7th in the state. The 2000 TPI reflected an increase of 7.3 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 state change was 6.7 percent and the national change was 8.0 percent. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of TPI was 2.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.0 percent and for the nation was 5.6 percent.

COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Kodiak Island Borough. In 2000 net earnings accounted for 66.8 percent of TPI (compared with 75.7 in 1990); dividends, interest, and rent were 18.0 percent (compared with 15.0 in 1990); and personal current transfer receipts were 15.3 percent (compared with 9.3 in 1990). From 1999 to 2000 net earnings increased 6.2 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 5.6 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 14.8 percent. From 1990 to 2000 net earnings increased on average 1.2 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 4.3 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 7.6 percent.

EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK

Earnings of persons employed in Kodiak Island Borough increased from \$304,298* in 1999 to \$322,327* in 2000, an increase of 5.9 percent. The 1999-2000 state change was 5.1 percent and the national change was 8.0 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1990 estimate of \$276,136* to the 2000 estimate was 1.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 3.0 percent and for the nation was 5.8 percent.
