



## **BEARFACTS 1990 – 2000**

### **Adair , Kentucky [21001]**

Adair is one of 120 counties in Kentucky. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2000 population of 17,285 ranked 63rd in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2000 Adair had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$18,114. This PCPI ranked 83rd in the state and was 74 percent of the state average, \$24,413, and 61 percent of the national average, \$29,847. The 2000 PCPI reflected an increase of 11.5 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 state change was 7.2 percent and the national change was 6.8 percent. In 1990 the PCPI of Adair was \$11,964 and ranked 72nd in the state. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.7 percent and for the nation was 4.4 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2000 Adair had a total personal income (TPI) of \$313,099\*. This TPI ranked 67th in the state and accounted for 0.3 percent of the state total. In 1990 the TPI of Adair was \$184,095\* and ranked 64th in the state. The 2000 TPI reflected an increase of 13.0 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 state change was 8.1 percent and the national change was 8.0 percent. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of TPI was 5.5 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.7 percent and for the nation was 5.6 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Adair. In 2000 net earnings accounted for 57.0 percent of TPI (compared with 60.2 in 1990); dividends, interest, and rent were 15.7 percent (compared with 16.0 in 1990); and personal current transfer receipts were 27.3 percent (compared with 23.8 in 1990). From 1999 to 2000 net earnings increased 16.6 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 11.7 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 6.9 percent. From 1990 to 2000 net earnings increased on average 4.9 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 5.2 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 6.9 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Adair increased from \$130,575\* in 1999 to \$153,180\* in 2000, an increase of 17.3 percent. The 1999-2000 state change was 7.0 percent and the national change was 8.0 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1990 estimate of \$94,665\* to the 2000 estimate was 4.9 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.7 percent and for the nation was 5.8 percent.
