



## **BEARFACTS 1990 – 2000**

### **Hickman , Kentucky [21105]**

Hickman is one of 120 counties in Kentucky. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2000 population of 5,248 ranked 118th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2000 Hickman had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$30,175. This PCPI ranked 5th in the state and was 124 percent of the state average, \$24,413, and 101 percent of the national average, \$29,847. The 2000 PCPI reflected an increase of 4.1 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 state change was 7.2 percent and the national change was 6.8 percent. In 1990 the PCPI of Hickman was \$13,319 and ranked 51st in the state. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 8.5 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.7 percent and for the nation was 4.4 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2000 Hickman had a total personal income (TPI) of \$158,358\*. This TPI ranked 109th in the state and accounted for 0.2 percent of the state total. In 1990 the TPI of Hickman was \$74,239\* and ranked 111th in the state. The 2000 TPI reflected an increase of 3.1 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 state change was 8.1 percent and the national change was 8.0 percent. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of TPI was 7.9 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.7 percent and for the nation was 5.6 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Hickman. In 2000 net earnings accounted for 73.2 percent of TPI (compared with 60.0 in 1990); dividends, interest, and rent were 11.4 percent (compared with 20.4 in 1990); and personal current transfer receipts were 15.4 percent (compared with 19.6 in 1990). From 1999 to 2000 net earnings increased 2.1 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 10.6 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 2.4 percent. From 1990 to 2000 net earnings increased on average 10.0 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 1.8 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 5.3 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Hickman increased from \$97,102\* in 1999 to \$98,318\* in 2000, an increase of 1.3 percent. The 1999-2000 state change was 7.0 percent and the national change was 8.0 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1990 estimate of \$33,897\* to the 2000 estimate was 11.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.7 percent and for the nation was 5.8 percent.
