



## **BEARFACTS 1990 – 2000**

### **Menifee , Kentucky [21165]**

Menifee is one of 120 counties in Kentucky. It is part of the Mount Sterling, KY Micropolitan SA. Its 2000 population of 6,595 ranked 116th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2000 Menifee had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$14,610. This PCPI ranked 114th in the state and was 60 percent of the state average, \$24,413, and 49 percent of the national average, \$29,847. The 2000 PCPI reflected an increase of 7.9 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 state change was 7.2 percent and the national change was 6.8 percent. In 1990 the PCPI of Menifee was \$9,455 and ranked 109th in the state. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.7 percent and for the nation was 4.4 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2000 Menifee had a total personal income (TPI) of \$96,351\*. This TPI ranked 117th in the state and accounted for 0.1 percent of the state total. In 1990 the TPI of Menifee was \$48,465\* and ranked 118th in the state. The 2000 TPI reflected an increase of 11.9 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 state change was 8.1 percent and the national change was 8.0 percent. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of TPI was 7.1 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.7 percent and for the nation was 5.6 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Menifee. In 2000 net earnings accounted for 57.6 percent of TPI (compared with 63.5 in 1990); dividends, interest, and rent were 11.4 percent (compared with 11.2 in 1990); and personal current transfer receipts were 31.0 percent (compared with 25.4 in 1990). From 1999 to 2000 net earnings increased 14.0 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 8.3 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 9.4 percent. From 1990 to 2000 net earnings increased on average 6.1 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 7.3 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 9.3 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Menifee increased from \$31,176\* in 1999 to \$34,787\* in 2000, an increase of 11.6 percent. The 1999-2000 state change was 7.0 percent and the national change was 8.0 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1990 estimate of \$17,172\* to the 2000 estimate was 7.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.7 percent and for the nation was 5.8 percent.
