



BEARFACTS 1990 – 2000

Trimble , Kentucky [21223]

Trimble is one of 120 counties in Kentucky. It is part of the [Louisville-Jefferson County, KY-IN \(MSA\)](#). Its 2000 population of 8,175 ranked 107th in the state.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2000 Trimble had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$15,839. This PCPI ranked 108th in the state and was 65 percent of the state average, \$24,413, and 53 percent of the national average, \$29,847. The 2000 PCPI reflected an increase of 12.5 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 state change was 7.2 percent and the national change was 6.8 percent. In 1990 the PCPI of Trimble was \$8,252 and ranked 119th in the state. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 6.7 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.7 percent and for the nation was 4.4 percent.

TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

In 2000 Trimble had a total personal income (TPI) of \$129,481*. This TPI ranked 112th in the state and accounted for 0.1 percent of the state total. In 1990 the TPI of Trimble was \$50,364* and ranked 117th in the state. The 2000 TPI reflected an increase of 15.2 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 state change was 8.1 percent and the national change was 8.0 percent. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of TPI was 9.9 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.7 percent and for the nation was 5.6 percent.

COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Trimble. In 2000 net earnings accounted for 61.1 percent of TPI (compared with 50.6 in 1990); dividends, interest, and rent were 15.9 percent (compared with 22.1 in 1990); and personal current transfer receipts were 22.9 percent (compared with 27.3 in 1990). From 1999 to 2000 net earnings increased 17.4 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 17.0 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 8.5 percent. From 1990 to 2000 net earnings increased on average 12.0 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 6.4 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 8.0 percent.

EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK

Earnings of persons employed in Trimble increased from \$34,058* in 1999 to \$36,379* in 2000, an increase of 6.8 percent. The 1999-2000 state change was 7.0 percent and the national change was 8.0 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1990 estimate of \$46,505* to the 2000 estimate was - 2.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.7 percent and for the nation was 5.8 percent.
