



BEARFACTS 1990 – 2000

West Baton Rouge , Louisiana [22121]

West Baton Rouge is one of 64 counties in Louisiana. It is part of the [Baton Rouge, LA \(MSA\)](#). Its 2000 population of 21,564 ranked 43rd in the state.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2000 West Baton Rouge had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$23,133. This PCPI ranked 10th in the state and was 100 percent of the state average, \$23,082, and 78 percent of the national average, \$29,847. The 2000 PCPI reflected an increase of 2.7 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 state change was 4.9 percent and the national change was 6.8 percent. In 1990 the PCPI of West Baton Rouge was \$14,952 and ranked 13th in the state. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.5 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.3 percent and for the nation was 4.4 percent.

TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

In 2000 West Baton Rouge had a total personal income (TPI) of \$498,848*. This TPI ranked 37th in the state and accounted for 0.5 percent of the state total. In 1990 the TPI of West Baton Rouge was \$290,376* and ranked 39th in the state. The 2000 TPI reflected an increase of 2.7 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 state change was 5.0 percent and the national change was 8.0 percent. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of TPI was 5.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.9 percent and for the nation was 5.6 percent.

COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of West Baton Rouge. In 2000 net earnings accounted for 73.8 percent of TPI (compared with 73.6 in 1990); dividends, interest, and rent were 11.7 percent (compared with 12.9 in 1990); and personal current transfer receipts were 14.5 percent (compared with 13.5 in 1990). From 1999 to 2000 net earnings increased 2.7 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 11.1 percent; and personal current transfer receipts decreased 3.2 percent. From 1990 to 2000 net earnings increased on average 5.6 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 4.5 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 6.3 percent.

EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK

Earnings of persons employed in West Baton Rouge increased from \$453,326* in 1999 to \$467,936* in 2000, an increase of 3.2 percent. The 1999-2000 state change was 4.2 percent and the national change was 8.0 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1990 estimate of \$234,002* to the 2000 estimate was 7.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.8 percent and for the nation was 5.8 percent.
