



BEARFACTS 1990 – 2000

Bollinger , Missouri [29017]

Bollinger is one of 115 counties in Missouri. It is part of the [Cape Girardeau-Jackson, MO-IL \(MSA\)](#). Its 2000 population of 12,053 ranked 82nd in the state.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2000 Bollinger had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$17,569. This PCPI ranked 100th in the state and was 64 percent of the state average, \$27,243, and 59 percent of the national average, \$29,847. The 2000 PCPI reflected an increase of 9.8 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 state change was 6.0 percent and the national change was 6.8 percent. In 1990 the PCPI of Bollinger was \$10,673 and ranked 105th in the state. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 5.1 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.4 percent and for the nation was 4.4 percent.

TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

In 2000 Bollinger had a total personal income (TPI) of \$211,754*. This TPI ranked 85th in the state and accounted for 0.1 percent of the state total. In 1990 the TPI of Bollinger was \$113,822* and ranked 90th in the state. The 2000 TPI reflected an increase of 11.3 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 state change was 6.9 percent and the national change was 8.0 percent. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of TPI was 6.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.4 percent and for the nation was 5.6 percent.

COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Bollinger. In 2000 net earnings accounted for 62.5 percent of TPI (compared with 60.7 in 1990); dividends, interest, and rent were 14.4 percent (compared with 17.6 in 1990); and personal current transfer receipts were 23.0 percent (compared with 21.7 in 1990). From 1999 to 2000 net earnings increased 11.4 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 11.8 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 10.6 percent. From 1990 to 2000 net earnings increased on average 6.7 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 4.4 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 7.0 percent.

EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK

Earnings of persons employed in Bollinger increased from \$59,368* in 1999 to \$69,581* in 2000, an increase of 17.2 percent. The 1999-2000 state change was 6.3 percent and the national change was 8.0 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1990 estimate of \$40,556* to the 2000 estimate was 5.5 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.4 percent and for the nation was 5.8 percent.
