



## **BEARFACTS 1990 – 2000**

### **Holt , Missouri [29087]**

Holt is one of 115 counties in Missouri. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2000 population of 5,324 ranked 109th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2000 Holt had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$22,242. This PCPI ranked 38th in the state and was 82 percent of the state average, \$27,243, and 75 percent of the national average, \$29,847. The 2000 PCPI reflected an increase of 6.6 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 state change was 6.0 percent and the national change was 6.8 percent. In 1990 the PCPI of Holt was \$14,223 and ranked 35th in the state. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.4 percent and for the nation was 4.4 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2000 Holt had a total personal income (TPI) of \$118,415\*. This TPI ranked 108th in the state and accounted for 0.1 percent of the state total. In 1990 the TPI of Holt was \$85,824\* and ranked 103rd in the state. The 2000 TPI reflected an increase of 4.4 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 state change was 6.9 percent and the national change was 8.0 percent. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of TPI was 3.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.4 percent and for the nation was 5.6 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Holt. In 2000 net earnings accounted for 55.5 percent of TPI (compared with 54.5 in 1990); dividends, interest, and rent were 22.6 percent (compared with 25.8 in 1990); and personal current transfer receipts were 21.9 percent (compared with 19.7 in 1990). From 1999 to 2000 net earnings increased 4.3 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 4.6 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 4.2 percent. From 1990 to 2000 net earnings increased on average 3.5 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 1.9 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 4.4 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Holt increased from \$50,871\* in 1999 to \$51,768\* in 2000, an increase of 1.8 percent. The 1999-2000 state change was 6.3 percent and the national change was 8.0 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1990 estimate of \$41,776\* to the 2000 estimate was 2.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.4 percent and for the nation was 5.8 percent.
