



## **BEARFACTS 1990 – 2000**

### **Judith Basin , Montana [30045]**

Judith Basin is one of 56 counties in Montana. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2000 population of 2,332 ranked 43rd in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2000 Judith Basin had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$18,633. This PCPI ranked 40th in the state and was 81 percent of the state average, \$22,934, and 62 percent of the national average, \$29,847. The 2000 PCPI reflected an increase of 2.3 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 state change was 6.2 percent and the national change was 6.8 percent. In 1990 the PCPI of Judith Basin was \$16,278 and ranked 10th in the state. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 1.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.0 percent and for the nation was 4.4 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2000 Judith Basin had a total personal income (TPI) of \$43,453\*. This TPI ranked 44th in the state and accounted for 0.2 percent of the state total. In 1990 the TPI of Judith Basin was \$37,064\* and ranked 43rd in the state. The 2000 TPI reflected an increase of 3.6 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 state change was 6.9 percent and the national change was 8.0 percent. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of TPI was 1.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.3 percent and for the nation was 5.6 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Judith Basin. In 2000 net earnings accounted for 45.9 percent of TPI (compared with 50.0 in 1990); dividends, interest, and rent were 36.0 percent (compared with 36.0 in 1990); and personal current transfer receipts were 18.1 percent (compared with 14.0 in 1990). From 1999 to 2000 net earnings increased 0.2 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 6.1 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 8.2 percent. From 1990 to 2000 net earnings increased on average 0.7 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 1.6 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 4.2 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Judith Basin decreased from \$17,056\* in 1999 to \$17,033\* in 2000, a decrease of 0.1 percent. The 1999-2000 state change was 5.6 percent and the national change was 8.0 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1990 estimate of \$17,393\* to the 2000 estimate was - 0.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.4 percent and for the nation was 5.8 percent.

*\*Note: All income estimates with the exception of PCPI are in thousands of dollars, not adjusted for inflation.*
