



BEARFACTS 1990 – 2000

McPherson , Nebraska [31117]

McPherson is one of 93 counties in Nebraska. It is part of the North Platte, NE Micropolitan SA. Its 2000 population of 531 ranked 92nd in the state.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2000 McPherson had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$11,657. This PCPI ranked 89th in the state and was 42 percent of the state average, \$27,626, and 39 percent of the national average, \$29,847. The 2000 PCPI reflected an increase of 5.0 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 state change was 4.4 percent and the national change was 6.8 percent. In 1990 the PCPI of McPherson was \$13,926 and ranked 84th in the state. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of PCPI was - 1.8 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.4 percent and for the nation was 4.4 percent.

TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

In 2000 McPherson had a total personal income (TPI) of \$6,190*. This TPI ranked 90th in the state and accounted for 0.0 percent of the state total. In 1990 the TPI of McPherson was \$7,673* and ranked 91st in the state. The 2000 TPI reflected an increase of 4.0 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 state change was 4.9 percent and the national change was 8.0 percent. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of TPI was - 2.1 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.2 percent and for the nation was 5.6 percent.

COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of McPherson. In 2000 net earnings accounted for 23.6 percent of TPI (compared with 57.1 in 1990); dividends, interest, and rent were 44.3 percent (compared with 28.8 in 1990); and personal current transfer receipts were 32.1 percent (compared with 14.2 in 1990). From 1999 to 2000 net earnings increased 11.2 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 2.0 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 2.0 percent. From 1990 to 2000 net earnings decreased on average 10.4 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 2.2 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 6.2 percent.

EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK

Earnings of persons employed in McPherson increased from \$- 123* in 1999 to \$1* in 2000. The 1999-2000 state change was 3.8 percent and the national change was 8.0 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1990 estimate of \$3,702* to the 2000 estimate was - 56.0 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.1 percent and for the nation was 5.8 percent.
