



## **BEARFACTS 1990 – 2000**

### **Omaha-Council Bluffs (MSA) [36540]**

Omaha-Council Bluffs is one of 363 Metropolitan Statistical Areas (MSAs) in the nation. Its 2000 population of 769,074 ranked 60th in the nation.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2000 Omaha-Council Bluffs had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$31,506. This PCPI ranked 51st in the United States and was 106 percent of the national average, \$29,847. The 2000 PCPI reflected an increase of 5.4 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 national change was 6.8 percent. In 1990 the PCPI of Omaha-Council Bluffs was \$19,325 and ranked 88th in the United States. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 5.0 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 4.4 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2000 Omaha-Council Bluffs had a total personal income (TPI) of \$24,230,391\*. This TPI ranked 59th in the United States. In 1990 the TPI of Omaha-Council Bluffs was \$13,293,632\* and ranked 59th in the United States. The 2000 TPI reflected an increase of 6.4 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 national change was 8.0 percent. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of TPI was 6.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.6 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Omaha-Council Bluffs. In 2000 net earnings accounted for 70.3 percent of TPI (compared with 70.1 in 1990); dividends, interest, and rent were 18.9 percent (compared with 19.0 in 1990); and personal current transfer receipts were 10.8 percent (compared with 10.8 in 1990). From 1999 to 2000 net earnings increased 5.8 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 9.6 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 5.3 percent. From 1990 to 2000 net earnings increased on average 6.2 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 6.1 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 6.2 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Omaha-Council Bluffs increased from \$18,328,830\* in 1999 to \$19,371,902\* in 2000, an increase of 5.7 percent. The 1999-2000 national change was 8.0 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1990 estimate of \$10,573,474\* to the 2000 estimate was 6.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.8 percent.
