



## **BEARFACTS 1990 – 2000**

### **Mahoning , Ohio [39099]**

Mahoning is one of 88 counties in Ohio. It is part of the [Youngstown-Warren-Boardman, OH-PA \(MSA\)](#). Its 2000 population of 257,042 ranked 10th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2000 Mahoning had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$24,784. This PCPI ranked 40th in the state and was 88 percent of the state average, \$28,207, and 83 percent of the national average, \$29,847. The 2000 PCPI reflected an increase of 4.6 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 state change was 5.0 percent and the national change was 6.8 percent. In 1990 the PCPI of Mahoning was \$16,910 and ranked 35th in the state. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.9 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.2 percent and for the nation was 4.4 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2000 Mahoning had a total personal income (TPI) of \$6,370,441\*. This TPI ranked 11th in the state and accounted for 2.0 percent of the state total. In 1990 the TPI of Mahoning was \$4,482,662\* and ranked 10th in the state. The 2000 TPI reflected an increase of 3.7 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 state change was 5.3 percent and the national change was 8.0 percent. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of TPI was 3.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.6 percent and for the nation was 5.6 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Mahoning. In 2000 net earnings accounted for 60.2 percent of TPI (compared with 58.9 in 1990); dividends, interest, and rent were 19.0 percent (compared with 20.0 in 1990); and personal current transfer receipts were 20.8 percent (compared with 21.1 in 1990). From 1999 to 2000 net earnings increased 3.0 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 4.9 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 4.8 percent. From 1990 to 2000 net earnings increased on average 3.8 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 3.1 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 3.4 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Mahoning increased from \$3,962,628\* in 1999 to \$4,036,972\* in 2000, an increase of 1.9 percent. The 1999-2000 state change was 4.8 percent and the national change was 8.0 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1990 estimate of \$2,943,399\* to the 2000 estimate was 3.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.8 percent and for the nation was 5.8 percent.
