



## **BEARFACTS 1990 – 2000**

### **Latimer , Oklahoma [40077]**

Latimer is one of 77 counties in Oklahoma. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2000 population of 10,653 ranked 57th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2000 Latimer had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$19,018. This PCPI ranked 47th in the state and was 78 percent of the state average, \$24,410, and 64 percent of the national average, \$29,847. The 2000 PCPI reflected an increase of 9.5 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 state change was 8.2 percent and the national change was 6.8 percent. In 1990 the PCPI of Latimer was \$11,375 and ranked 68th in the state. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 5.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.2 percent and for the nation was 4.4 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2000 Latimer had a total personal income (TPI) of \$202,594\*. This TPI ranked 54th in the state and accounted for 0.2 percent of the state total. In 1990 the TPI of Latimer was \$117,891\* and ranked 60th in the state. The 2000 TPI reflected an increase of 9.4 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 state change was 8.7 percent and the national change was 8.0 percent. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of TPI was 5.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.2 percent and for the nation was 5.6 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Latimer. In 2000 net earnings accounted for 58.1 percent of TPI (compared with 57.7 in 1990); dividends, interest, and rent were 17.9 percent (compared with 19.2 in 1990); and personal current transfer receipts were 24.1 percent (compared with 23.1 in 1990). From 1999 to 2000 net earnings increased 10.1 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 12.8 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 5.5 percent. From 1990 to 2000 net earnings increased on average 5.6 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 4.8 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 6.0 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Latimer increased from \$125,589\* in 1999 to \$141,825\* in 2000, an increase of 12.9 percent. The 1999-2000 state change was 7.8 percent and the national change was 8.0 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1990 estimate of \$75,671\* to the 2000 estimate was 6.5 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.1 percent and for the nation was 5.8 percent.
