



BEARFACTS 1990 – 2000

Bandera , Texas [48019]

Bandera is one of 254 counties in Texas. It is part of the [San Antonio, TX \(MSA\)](#). Its 2000 population of 17,812 ranked 127th in the state.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2000 Bandera had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$25,800. This PCPI ranked 39th in the state and was 91 percent of the state average, \$28,317, and 86 percent of the national average, \$29,847. The 2000 PCPI reflected an increase of 10.8 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 state change was 7.9 percent and the national change was 6.8 percent. In 1990 the PCPI of Bandera was \$15,551 and ranked 87th in the state. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 5.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.0 percent and for the nation was 4.4 percent.

TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

In 2000 Bandera had a total personal income (TPI) of \$459,546*. This TPI ranked 109th in the state and accounted for 0.1 percent of the state total. In 1990 the TPI of Bandera was \$165,287* and ranked 150th in the state. The 2000 TPI reflected an increase of 15.8 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 state change was 9.9 percent and the national change was 8.0 percent. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of TPI was 10.8 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 7.2 percent and for the nation was 5.6 percent.

COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Bandera. In 2000 net earnings accounted for 66.4 percent of TPI (compared with 60.5 in 1990); dividends, interest, and rent were 20.3 percent (compared with 25.0 in 1990); and personal current transfer receipts were 13.3 percent (compared with 14.6 in 1990). From 1999 to 2000 net earnings increased 16.8 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 16.9 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 9.3 percent. From 1990 to 2000 net earnings increased on average 11.8 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 8.5 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 9.8 percent.

EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK

Earnings of persons employed in Bandera increased from \$92,317* in 1999 to \$113,389* in 2000, an increase of 22.8 percent. The 1999-2000 state change was 9.9 percent and the national change was 8.0 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1990 estimate of \$46,286* to the 2000 estimate was 9.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 7.6 percent and for the nation was 5.8 percent.
