



## **BEARFACTS 1990 – 2000**

### **Upshur , Texas [48459]**

Upshur is one of 254 counties in Texas. It is part of the [Longview, TX \(MSA\)](#). Its 2000 population of 35,362 ranked 78th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2000 Upshur had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$21,227. This PCPI ranked 126th in the state and was 75 percent of the state average, \$28,317, and 71 percent of the national average, \$29,847. The 2000 PCPI reflected an increase of 6.6 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 state change was 7.9 percent and the national change was 6.8 percent. In 1990 the PCPI of Upshur was \$13,004 and ranked 191st in the state. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 5.0 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.0 percent and for the nation was 4.4 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2000 Upshur had a total personal income (TPI) of \$750,644\*. This TPI ranked 74th in the state and accounted for 0.1 percent of the state total. In 1990 the TPI of Upshur was \$407,852\* and ranked 80th in the state. The 2000 TPI reflected an increase of 7.2 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 state change was 9.9 percent and the national change was 8.0 percent. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of TPI was 6.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 7.2 percent and for the nation was 5.6 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Upshur. In 2000 net earnings accounted for 64.9 percent of TPI (compared with 64.5 in 1990); dividends, interest, and rent were 14.6 percent (compared with 17.3 in 1990); and personal current transfer receipts were 20.5 percent (compared with 18.1 in 1990). From 1999 to 2000 net earnings increased 7.1 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 10.3 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 5.6 percent. From 1990 to 2000 net earnings increased on average 6.3 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 4.5 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 7.6 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Upshur increased from \$243,901\* in 1999 to \$263,201\* in 2000, an increase of 7.9 percent. The 1999-2000 state change was 9.9 percent and the national change was 8.0 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1990 estimate of \$143,700\* to the 2000 estimate was 6.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 7.6 percent and for the nation was 5.8 percent.
