



## **BEARFACTS 1990 – 2000**

### **Spotsylvania + Fredericksburg , Virginia [51951]**

Spotsylvania + Fredericksburg is one of 105 counties in Virginia. It is part of the [Washington-Arlington-Alexandria, DC-VA-MD-WV \(MSA\)](#). Its 2000 population of 110,870 ranked 16th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2000 Spotsylvania + Fredericksburg had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$28,363. This PCPI ranked 22nd in the state and was 91 percent of the state average, \$31,086, and 95 percent of the national average, \$29,847. The 2000 PCPI reflected an increase of 9.4 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 state change was 6.4 percent and the national change was 6.8 percent. In 1990 the PCPI of Spotsylvania + Fredericksburg was \$18,894 and ranked 20th in the state. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.1 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.3 percent and for the nation was 4.4 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2000 Spotsylvania + Fredericksburg had a total personal income (TPI) of \$3,144,657\*. This TPI ranked 16th in the state and accounted for 1.4 percent of the state total. In 1990 the TPI of Spotsylvania + Fredericksburg was \$1,478,209\* and ranked 21st in the state. The 2000 TPI reflected an increase of 13.7 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 state change was 7.9 percent and the national change was 8.0 percent. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of TPI was 7.8 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.7 percent and for the nation was 5.6 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Spotsylvania + Fredericksburg. In 2000 net earnings accounted for 76.2 percent of TPI (compared with 75.5 in 1990); dividends, interest, and rent were 14.8 percent (compared with 16.0 in 1990); and personal current transfer receipts were 9.0 percent (compared with 8.4 in 1990). From 1999 to 2000 net earnings increased 14.9 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 10.1 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 9.8 percent. From 1990 to 2000 net earnings increased on average 7.9 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 7.0 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 8.6 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Spotsylvania + Fredericksburg increased from \$1,568,116\* in 1999 to \$1,738,071\* in 2000, an increase of 10.8 percent. The 1999-2000 state change was 9.2 percent and the national change was 8.0 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1990 estimate of \$833,333\* to the 2000 estimate was 7.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.9 percent and for the nation was 5.8 percent.
