



## **BEARFACTS 1990 – 2000**

### **Chippewa , Wisconsin [55017]**

Chippewa is one of 72 counties in Wisconsin. It is part of the [Eau Claire, WI \(MSA\)](#). Its 2000 population of 55,326 ranked 25th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2000 Chippewa had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$25,029. This PCPI ranked 34th in the state and was 88 percent of the state average, \$28,572, and 84 percent of the national average, \$29,847. The 2000 PCPI reflected an increase of 5.0 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 state change was 5.3 percent and the national change was 6.8 percent. In 1990 the PCPI of Chippewa was \$15,345 and ranked 32nd in the state. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 5.0 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.7 percent and for the nation was 4.4 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2000 Chippewa had a total personal income (TPI) of \$1,384,769\*. This TPI ranked 26th in the state and accounted for 0.9 percent of the state total. In 1990 the TPI of Chippewa was \$803,979\* and ranked 24th in the state. The 2000 TPI reflected an increase of 6.1 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 state change was 6.1 percent and the national change was 8.0 percent. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of TPI was 5.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.6 percent and for the nation was 5.6 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Chippewa. In 2000 net earnings accounted for 65.7 percent of TPI (compared with 62.9 in 1990); dividends, interest, and rent were 18.8 percent (compared with 18.5 in 1990); and personal current transfer receipts were 15.6 percent (compared with 18.7 in 1990). From 1999 to 2000 net earnings increased 4.8 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 8.8 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 8.2 percent. From 1990 to 2000 net earnings increased on average 6.1 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 5.8 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 3.7 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Chippewa increased from \$854,066\* in 1999 to \$859,032\* in 2000, an increase of 0.6 percent. The 1999-2000 state change was 5.0 percent and the national change was 8.0 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1990 estimate of \$522,252\* to the 2000 estimate was 5.1 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.8 percent and for the nation was 5.8 percent.
