



## **BEARFACTS 1990 – 2000**

### **Natrona , Wyoming [56025]**

Natrona is one of 23 counties in Wyoming. It is part of the [Casper, WY \(MSA\)](#). Its 2000 population of 66,557 ranked 2nd in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2000 Natrona had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$33,907. This PCPI ranked 2nd in the state and was 119 percent of the state average, \$28,470, and 114 percent of the national average, \$29,847. The 2000 PCPI reflected an increase of 15.3 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 state change was 7.3 percent and the national change was 6.8 percent. In 1990 the PCPI of Natrona was \$21,732 and ranked 2nd in the state. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.5 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.7 percent and for the nation was 4.4 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2000 Natrona had a total personal income (TPI) of \$2,256,752\*. This TPI ranked 2nd in the state and accounted for 16.0 percent of the state total. In 1990 the TPI of Natrona was \$1,332,073\* and ranked 2nd in the state. The 2000 TPI reflected an increase of 15.8 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 state change was 7.8 percent and the national change was 8.0 percent. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of TPI was 5.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.6 percent and for the nation was 5.6 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Natrona. In 2000 net earnings accounted for 66.7 percent of TPI (compared with 67.1 in 1990); dividends, interest, and rent were 22.0 percent (compared with 22.5 in 1990); and personal current transfer receipts were 11.2 percent (compared with 10.4 in 1990). From 1999 to 2000 net earnings increased 20.4 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 7.4 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 7.9 percent. From 1990 to 2000 net earnings increased on average 5.4 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 5.2 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 6.2 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Natrona increased from \$1,388,207\* in 1999 to \$1,670,598\* in 2000, an increase of 20.3 percent. The 1999-2000 state change was 7.4 percent and the national change was 8.0 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1990 estimate of \$982,695\* to the 2000 estimate was 5.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.8 percent and for the nation was 5.8 percent.
