



## **BEARFACTS 1990 – 2000**

### **Midland-Odessa (BEA-EA) [57107]**

Midland-Odessa is one of 179 BEA Economic Areas in the nation. Its 2000 population of 534,312 ranked 109th in the nation.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2000 Midland-Odessa had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$23,099. This PCPI ranked 128th in the United States and was 77 percent of the national average, \$29,847. The 2000 PCPI reflected an increase of 10.1 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 national change was 6.8 percent. In 1990 the PCPI of Midland-Odessa was \$15,597 and ranked 121st in the United States. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.0 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 4.4 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2000 Midland-Odessa had a total personal income (TPI) of \$12,341,892\*. This TPI ranked 111th in the United States. In 1990 the TPI of Midland-Odessa was \$8,183,041\* and ranked 104th in the United States. The 2000 TPI reflected an increase of 8.2 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 national change was 8.0 percent. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of TPI was 4.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.6 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Midland-Odessa. In 2000 net earnings accounted for 65.8 percent of TPI (compared with 65.9 in 1990); dividends, interest, and rent were 18.0 percent (compared with 21.7 in 1990); and personal current transfer receipts were 16.3 percent (compared with 12.5 in 1990). From 1999 to 2000 net earnings increased 9.0 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 9.4 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 4.1 percent. From 1990 to 2000 net earnings increased on average 4.2 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 2.3 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 7.0 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Midland-Odessa increased from \$8,269,975\* in 1999 to \$8,994,050\* in 2000, an increase of 8.8 percent. The 1999-2000 national change was 8.0 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1990 estimate of \$5,973,805\* to the 2000 estimate was 4.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.8 percent.

*\*Note: All income estimates with the exception of PCPI are in thousands of dollars, not adjusted for inflation.*
