



## **BEARFACTS 1990 – 2000**

### **Rochester-Batavia-Seneca Falls (BEA-EA) [57139]**

Rochester-Batavia-Seneca Falls is one of 179 BEA Economic Areas in the nation. Its 2000 population of 1,523,370 ranked 47th in the nation.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2000 Rochester-Batavia-Seneca Falls had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$27,478. This PCPI ranked 46th in the United States and was 92 percent of the national average, \$29,847. The 2000 PCPI reflected an increase of 5.5 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 national change was 6.8 percent. In 1990 the PCPI of Rochester-Batavia-Seneca Falls was \$19,140 and ranked 27th in the United States. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.7 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 4.4 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2000 Rochester-Batavia-Seneca Falls had a total personal income (TPI) of \$41,859,492\*. This TPI ranked 49th in the United States. In 1990 the TPI of Rochester-Batavia-Seneca Falls was \$28,442,090\* and ranked 37th in the United States. The 2000 TPI reflected an increase of 5.9 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 national change was 8.0 percent. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of TPI was 3.9 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.6 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Rochester-Batavia-Seneca Falls. In 2000 net earnings accounted for 66.3 percent of TPI (compared with 67.5 in 1990); dividends, interest, and rent were 17.3 percent (compared with 18.8 in 1990); and personal current transfer receipts were 16.4 percent (compared with 13.7 in 1990). From 1999 to 2000 net earnings increased 5.7 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 7.1 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 5.6 percent. From 1990 to 2000 net earnings increased on average 3.8 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 3.1 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 5.8 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Rochester-Batavia-Seneca Falls increased from \$29,560,718\* in 1999 to \$31,177,849\* in 2000, an increase of 5.5 percent. The 1999-2000 national change was 8.0 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1990 estimate of \$21,674,871\* to the 2000 estimate was 3.7 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.8 percent.
