



## **BEARFACTS 1990 – 2000**

### **Salina (BEA-EA) [57141]**

Salina is one of 179 BEA Economic Areas in the nation. Its 2000 population of 199,355 ranked 165th in the nation.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2000 Salina had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$23,981. This PCPI ranked 104th in the United States and was 80 percent of the national average, \$29,847. The 2000 PCPI reflected an increase of 2.0 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 national change was 6.8 percent. In 1990 the PCPI of Salina was \$17,386 and ranked 60th in the United States. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 4.4 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2000 Salina had a total personal income (TPI) of \$4,780,809\*. This TPI ranked 165th in the United States. In 1990 the TPI of Salina was \$3,485,753\* and ranked 154th in the United States. The 2000 TPI reflected an increase of 1.5 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 national change was 8.0 percent. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of TPI was 3.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.6 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Salina. In 2000 net earnings accounted for 58.9 percent of TPI (compared with 61.5 in 1990); dividends, interest, and rent were 23.5 percent (compared with 23.4 in 1990); and personal current transfer receipts were 17.6 percent (compared with 15.2 in 1990). From 1999 to 2000 net earnings decreased 2.4 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 8.8 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 6.1 percent. From 1990 to 2000 net earnings increased on average 2.8 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 3.3 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 4.8 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Salina decreased from \$3,257,141\* in 1999 to \$3,206,681\* in 2000, a decrease of 1.5 percent. The 1999-2000 national change was 8.0 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1990 estimate of \$2,368,699\* to the 2000 estimate was 3.1 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.8 percent.

*\*Note: All income estimates with the exception of PCPI are in thousands of dollars, not adjusted for inflation.*
