



## **BEARFACTS 1991 – 2001**

### **Bristol Bay Borough , Alaska [02060]**

Bristol Bay Borough is one of 27 counties in Alaska. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2001 population of 1,181 ranked 26th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2001 Bristol Bay Borough had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$37,574. This PCPI ranked 2nd in the state and was 119 percent of the state average, \$31,666, and 123 percent of the national average, \$30,582. The 2001 PCPI reflected an increase of 8.4 percent from 2000. The 2000-2001 state change was 6.0 percent and the national change was 2.5 percent. In 1991 the PCPI of Bristol Bay Borough was \$34,364 and ranked 1st in the state. The 1991-2001 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 0.9 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 3.2 percent and for the nation was 4.4 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2001 Bristol Bay Borough had a total personal income (TPI) of \$44,375\*. This TPI ranked 25th in the state and accounted for 0.2 percent of the state total. In 1991 the TPI of Bristol Bay Borough was \$49,141\* and ranked 24th in the state. The 2001 TPI reflected an increase of 4.1 percent from 2000. The 2000-2001 state change was 7.0 percent and the national change was 3.5 percent. The 1991-2001 average annual growth rate of TPI was - 1.0 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.3 percent and for the nation was 5.6 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Bristol Bay Borough. In 2001 net earnings accounted for 68.5 percent of TPI (compared with 80.4 in 1991); dividends, interest, and rent were 16.1 percent (compared with 12.8 in 1991); and personal current transfer receipts were 15.4 percent (compared with 6.8 in 1991). From 2000 to 2001 net earnings increased 4.8 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 3.9 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 10.4 percent. From 1991 to 2001 net earnings decreased on average 2.6 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 1.3 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 7.4 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Bristol Bay Borough increased from \$54,413\* in 2000 to \$55,416\* in 2001, an increase of 1.8 percent. The 2000-2001 state change was 9.0 percent and the national change was 3.1 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1991 estimate of \$60,854\* to the 2001 estimate was - 0.9 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 3.4 percent and for the nation was 5.8 percent.
