



## **BEARFACTS 1991 – 2001**

### **Coeur d'Alene (MSA) [17660]**

Coeur d'Alene is one of 363 Metropolitan Statistical Areas (MSAs) in the nation. Its 2001 population of 111,719 ranked 309th in the nation.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2001 Coeur d'Alene had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$23,725. This PCPI ranked 300th in the United States and was 78 percent of the national average, \$30,582. The 2001 PCPI reflected an increase of 3.1 percent from 2000. The 2000-2001 national change was 2.5 percent. In 1991 the PCPI of Coeur d'Alene was \$16,320 and ranked 260th in the United States. The 1991-2001 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.8 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 4.4 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2001 Coeur d'Alene had a total personal income (TPI) of \$2,650,520\*. This TPI ranked 313th in the United States. In 1991 the TPI of Coeur d'Alene was \$1,206,822\* and ranked 359th in the United States. The 2001 TPI reflected an increase of 5.1 percent from 2000. The 2000-2001 national change was 3.5 percent. The 1991-2001 average annual growth rate of TPI was 8.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.6 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Coeur d'Alene. In 2001 net earnings accounted for 64.4 percent of TPI (compared with 63.7 in 1991); dividends, interest, and rent were 19.3 percent (compared with 21.1 in 1991); and personal current transfer receipts were 16.2 percent (compared with 15.2 in 1991). From 2000 to 2001 net earnings increased 4.0 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 2.6 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 13.4 percent. From 1991 to 2001 net earnings increased on average 8.3 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 7.3 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 8.9 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Coeur d'Alene increased from \$1,574,377\* in 2000 to \$1,662,340\* in 2001, an increase of 5.6 percent. The 2000-2001 national change was 3.1 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1991 estimate of \$734,009\* to the 2001 estimate was 8.5 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.8 percent.

*\*Note: All income estimates with the exception of PCPI are in thousands of dollars, not adjusted for inflation.*
