



BEARFACTS 1991 – 2001

Huntington , Indiana [18069]

Huntington is one of 92 counties in Indiana. It is part of the Huntington, IN Micropolitan SA. Its 2001 population of 37,973 ranked 39th in the state.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2001 Huntington had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$25,211. This PCPI ranked 32nd in the state and was 92 percent of the state average, \$27,414, and 82 percent of the national average, \$30,582. The 2001 PCPI reflected a decrease of 0.4 percent from 2000. The 2000-2001 state change was 1.0 percent and the national change was 2.5 percent. In 1991 the PCPI of Huntington was \$16,718 and ranked 31st in the state. The 1991-2001 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.4 percent and for the nation was 4.4 percent.

TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

In 2001 Huntington had a total personal income (TPI) of \$957,354*. This TPI ranked 38th in the state and accounted for 0.6 percent of the state total. In 1991 the TPI of Huntington was \$599,360* and ranked 37th in the state. The 2001 TPI reflected a decrease of 0.7 percent from 2000. The 2000-2001 state change was 1.6 percent and the national change was 3.5 percent. The 1991-2001 average annual growth rate of TPI was 4.8 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.3 percent and for the nation was 5.6 percent.

COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Huntington. In 2001 net earnings accounted for 68.4 percent of TPI (compared with 67.2 in 1991); dividends, interest, and rent were 16.9 percent (compared with 19.2 in 1991); and personal current transfer receipts were 14.7 percent (compared with 13.7 in 1991). From 2000 to 2001 net earnings decreased 2.2 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 3.2 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 10.6 percent. From 1991 to 2001 net earnings increased on average 5.0 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 3.5 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 5.6 percent.

EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK

Earnings of persons employed in Huntington decreased from \$550,179* in 2000 to \$548,373* in 2001, a decrease of 0.3 percent. The 2000-2001 state change was 0.8 percent and the national change was 3.1 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1991 estimate of \$347,858* to the 2001 estimate was 4.7 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.2 percent and for the nation was 5.8 percent.
