



## **BEARFACTS 1991 – 2001**

### **Mitchell , Iowa [19131]**

Mitchell is one of 99 counties in Iowa. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2001 population of 10,739 ranked 76th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2001 Mitchell had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$23,970. This PCPI ranked 61st in the state and was 88 percent of the state average, \$27,125, and 78 percent of the national average, \$30,582. The 2001 PCPI reflected an increase of 0.3 percent from 2000. The 2000-2001 state change was 2.1 percent and the national change was 2.5 percent. In 1991 the PCPI of Mitchell was \$17,849 and ranked 16th in the state. The 1991-2001 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.0 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.3 percent and for the nation was 4.4 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2001 Mitchell had a total personal income (TPI) of \$257,418\*. This TPI ranked 77th in the state and accounted for 0.3 percent of the state total. In 1991 the TPI of Mitchell was \$194,503\* and ranked 66th in the state. The 2001 TPI reflected a decrease of 0.9 percent from 2000. The 2000-2001 state change was 2.2 percent and the national change was 3.5 percent. The 1991-2001 average annual growth rate of TPI was 2.8 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.8 percent and for the nation was 5.6 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Mitchell. In 2001 net earnings accounted for 55.8 percent of TPI (compared with 58.2 in 1991); dividends, interest, and rent were 26.2 percent (compared with 26.8 in 1991); and personal current transfer receipts were 18.0 percent (compared with 15.0 in 1991). From 2000 to 2001 net earnings decreased 4.6 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 2.4 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 6.9 percent. From 1991 to 2001 net earnings increased on average 2.4 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 2.6 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 4.8 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Mitchell decreased from \$148,066\* in 2000 to \$139,718\* in 2001, a decrease of 5.6 percent. The 2000-2001 state change was 1.7 percent and the national change was 3.1 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1991 estimate of \$108,127\* to the 2001 estimate was 2.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.0 percent and for the nation was 5.8 percent.
