



## **BEARFACTS 1991 – 2001**

### **Hooker , Nebraska [31091]**

Hooker is one of 93 counties in Nebraska. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2001 population of 753 ranked 87th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2001 Hooker had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$15,272. This PCPI ranked 87th in the state and was 53 percent of the state average, \$28,703, and 50 percent of the national average, \$30,582. The 2001 PCPI reflected an increase of 15.8 percent from 2000. The 2000-2001 state change was 3.9 percent and the national change was 2.5 percent. In 1991 the PCPI of Hooker was \$13,233 and ranked 84th in the state. The 1991-2001 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 1.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.5 percent and for the nation was 4.4 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2001 Hooker had a total personal income (TPI) of \$11,500\*. This TPI ranked 87th in the state and accounted for 0.0 percent of the state total. In 1991 the TPI of Hooker was \$10,454\* and ranked 86th in the state. The 2001 TPI reflected an increase of 11.5 percent from 2000. The 2000-2001 state change was 4.2 percent and the national change was 3.5 percent. The 1991-2001 average annual growth rate of TPI was 1.0 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.2 percent and for the nation was 5.6 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Hooker. In 2001 net earnings accounted for 14.4 percent of TPI (compared with 33.2 in 1991); dividends, interest, and rent were 48.6 percent (compared with 40.3 in 1991); and personal current transfer receipts were 37.0 percent (compared with 26.5 in 1991). From 2000 to 2001 net earnings increased 106.1 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 2.5 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 5.0 percent. From 1991 to 2001 net earnings decreased on average 7.2 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 2.9 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 4.4 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Hooker decreased from \$2,061\* in 2000 to \$1,779\* in 2001, a decrease of 13.7 percent. The 2000-2001 state change was 4.3 percent and the national change was 3.1 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1991 estimate of \$4,788\* to the 2001 estimate was -9.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.2 percent and for the nation was 5.8 percent.

*\*Note: All income estimates with the exception of PCPI are in thousands of dollars, not adjusted for inflation.*
