



## **BEARFACTS 1991 – 2001**

### **San Diego-Carlsbad-San Marcos (MSA) [41740]**

San Diego-Carlsbad-San Marcos is one of 363 Metropolitan Statistical Areas (MSAs) in the nation. Its 2001 population of 2,869,630 ranked 17th in the nation.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2001 San Diego-Carlsbad-San Marcos had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$33,806. This PCPI ranked 35th in the United States and was 111 percent of the national average, \$30,582. The 2001 PCPI reflected an increase of 3.1 percent from 2000. The 2000-2001 national change was 2.5 percent. In 1991 the PCPI of San Diego-Carlsbad-San Marcos was \$21,168 and ranked 47th in the United States. The 1991-2001 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.8 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 4.4 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2001 San Diego-Carlsbad-San Marcos had a total personal income (TPI) of \$97,009,480\*. This TPI ranked 16th in the United States. In 1991 the TPI of San Diego-Carlsbad-San Marcos was \$54,045,134\* and ranked 15th in the United States. The 2001 TPI reflected an increase of 4.7 percent from 2000. The 2000-2001 national change was 3.5 percent. The 1991-2001 average annual growth rate of TPI was 6.0 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.6 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of San Diego-Carlsbad-San Marcos. In 2001 net earnings accounted for 69.4 percent of TPI (compared with 67.1 in 1991); dividends, interest, and rent were 19.5 percent (compared with 21.5 in 1991); and personal current transfer receipts were 11.1 percent (compared with 11.4 in 1991). From 2000 to 2001 net earnings increased 4.4 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 2.5 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 11.0 percent. From 1991 to 2001 net earnings increased on average 6.4 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 5.0 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 5.7 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in San Diego-Carlsbad-San Marcos increased from \$71,859,228\* in 2000 to \$75,317,745\* in 2001, an increase of 4.8 percent. The 2000-2001 national change was 3.1 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1991 estimate of \$40,369,491\* to the 2001 estimate was 6.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.8 percent.
