



## **BEARFACTS 1991 – 2001**

### **Huntingdon , Pennsylvania [42061]**

Huntingdon is one of 67 counties in Pennsylvania. It is part of the Huntingdon, PA Micropolitan SA. Its 2001 population of 45,562 ranked 48th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2001 Huntingdon had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$20,112. This PCPI ranked 67th in the state and was 66 percent of the state average, \$30,310, and 66 percent of the national average, \$30,582. The 2001 PCPI reflected an increase of 3.7 percent from 2000. The 2000-2001 state change was 2.1 percent and the national change was 2.5 percent. In 1991 the PCPI of Huntingdon was \$13,354 and ranked 66th in the state. The 1991-2001 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.1 percent and for the nation was 4.4 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2001 Huntingdon had a total personal income (TPI) of \$916,361\*. This TPI ranked 55th in the state and accounted for 0.2 percent of the state total. In 1991 the TPI of Huntingdon was \$592,810\* and ranked 55th in the state. The 2001 TPI reflected an increase of 3.6 percent from 2000. The 2000-2001 state change was 2.1 percent and the national change was 3.5 percent. The 1991-2001 average annual growth rate of TPI was 4.5 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.4 percent and for the nation was 5.6 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Huntingdon. In 2001 net earnings accounted for 61.3 percent of TPI (compared with 61.3 in 1991); dividends, interest, and rent were 16.0 percent (compared with 18.3 in 1991); and personal current transfer receipts were 22.7 percent (compared with 20.4 in 1991). From 2000 to 2001 net earnings increased 1.2 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 2.3 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 11.7 percent. From 1991 to 2001 net earnings increased on average 4.4 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 3.1 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 5.6 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Huntingdon increased from \$485,275\* in 2000 to \$493,385\* in 2001, an increase of 1.7 percent. The 2000-2001 state change was 2.0 percent and the national change was 3.1 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1991 estimate of \$341,992\* to the 2001 estimate was 3.7 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.5 percent and for the nation was 5.8 percent.

*\*Note: All income estimates with the exception of PCPI are in thousands of dollars, not adjusted for inflation.*

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
